Special election to authorize renewal of/and addition to excess levies for the years beginning July 1, 1994, July 1, 1995, July 1, 1996, July 1, 1997, July 1, 1998, for the purpose of the General Current Expense Fund, according to the order of the Board of Education of the County of Monroe entered on the 22nd day of December, 1993.

- \$100,000.00—To furnish free textbooks and materials to all students in grades Early Childhood (kindergarten) through twelve (12) inclusive.
 - \$174,925.00—To continue to provide to all professional personnel a supplementary salary of \$100.00 per month above State minimum, making it possible for the Monroe County Board of Education to remain competitive in the recruiting of personnel.
 - \$20,176.00—To continue to provide a supplementary salary of \$20.00 per month above (c)
 - State minimum salary scale to all service personnel.

 To continue to provide matching funds for payment of fixed charges on salaries provided by levy for all personnel employed by the Board of Education of the Monroe County School District and to pay the county share of public employee insurance and local retirement. (d) retirement.
 - To provide an amount not to exceed \$50.00 per studen to the school housing each K-8 student so that field trips, play ground equipment, and special materials for classroom or other student use may be distributed to students without the necessity of fund-raising. To provide for activity buses as needed to depart from the schools in the evening, taking students to drop-off points throughout the county. (e)

 - salaries at an amount not to exceed \$76,000 per fiscal To provide for extracurricular (g) year.
 - To provide an amount not to exceed \$50,000 as needed to supplement Step VI of the West Virginia Funding Formula for the purpose of providing substitutes for both professional and service personnel employees. (h)
 - To provide for enrichment and/or improvement of educational programs and facilities for students in grades K-8 of the Monroe County School System by expenditures of any surplus of funds accruing in excess of the amounts needed for above named services.
- 2. That the annual approximate amount needed during each fiscal year of this levy \$635,583.00, and the total approximate amount to be expended during the term of this levy is \$3,177,915.00.
- 3. That the proposed additional rate of levy in cents on each class of property is as follows: Class I: 19.51; Class II, 39.01; Class III, 78.03; Class IV, 78.03. This is 85% of the maximum allowable levy rate.
